The assessment of the fulfilment of the publication requirements takes place on the basis of the data entered into the MTMT and to the ODT database. In the case of publications with more than one author, the score is divided by the number of participants and rounded to a whole number.

Acknowledgement of a publication is certified by the advisor.

In the case of any fulfilment that cannot be placed in the categories listed in the table, the DSC makes the decision on whether to accept the publication and on the value of the credit on the basis of the recommendation of the advisor.

Only the work performed in the given semester or the academic year may be taken into account.

Minimum publication requirements in the training and research phase (also a precondition for the complex examination)

	Credit value
The publication of a study presenting the research results achieved in the first year, in printed media or on an internet site related to the profession independent of the DSA	4
The publication of a study presenting the research results achieved in the second year, in printed media or on an internet site related to the profession independent of the DSA	4
Publication of the compulsory work submitted to the design competition in the first year if granted an award	4
Publication of the compulsory work submitted to the design competition in the second year if granted an award	4

Publication requirements in the thesis phase

Publication of a written work presenting the student's research in years 3 and 4 forming the basis of the thesis and/or a study linked to the topic, as follows:

	Credit value
The publication of one proofed article published in a printed book, specialist periodical or internet site independent of the DSA and having an ISBN ID or the publications of two articles published in any printed book, specialist periodical or internet site independent of the DSA	6
Publication of the masterwork in any printed book, specialist periodical or internet site independent of the DSA If the masterwork cannot be published for any reason (e.g. confidential work, or if still being written in the last active semester), it may be replaced by the publication of another architectural work (design, completed work).	10

Explanatory notes

Two "milestones": 16 credits, i.e. 4 4-credit subjects in years 1-2, and a further 16 credits, i.e. 4 4-credit subjects in years 3-4 must be completed.

When submitting the dissertation, the CV must include a list of publications.

The dissertation in Architecture is not based on a publication, but on a written text and a portfolio, with emphasis on the masterwork. There is no publication requirement beyond the publication requirements fulfilled during the training.

Not accepted as a publication:

- 1_conference abstract
- 2_conference lecture
- 3_workshop participation, round table discussion
- 4_participation in an exhibition and/or organisation of an exhibition
- 5_participation and award in a design competition (neither a news item announcing the outcome of the competition)
- 6_prizes, other awards
- 7_interviews by others

Additional rules:

- 1_for multiple-author articles (including the masterwork), the credit value is divided by the number of authors

2_ if the text of the publication of an architectural work (including the masterwork) is written by another author, the credits are divided in the given authorship ratio

3_ publication in an edited publication counts as a publication only if it is about the masterwork or, in the case of a non-publishable masterwork, about another work (otherwise it counts as a reference)

4_ a publication in progress but not yet published (subject to submission of a certificate) may be recognised only if it is necessary for the complex examination or for the pre-degree certificate.
